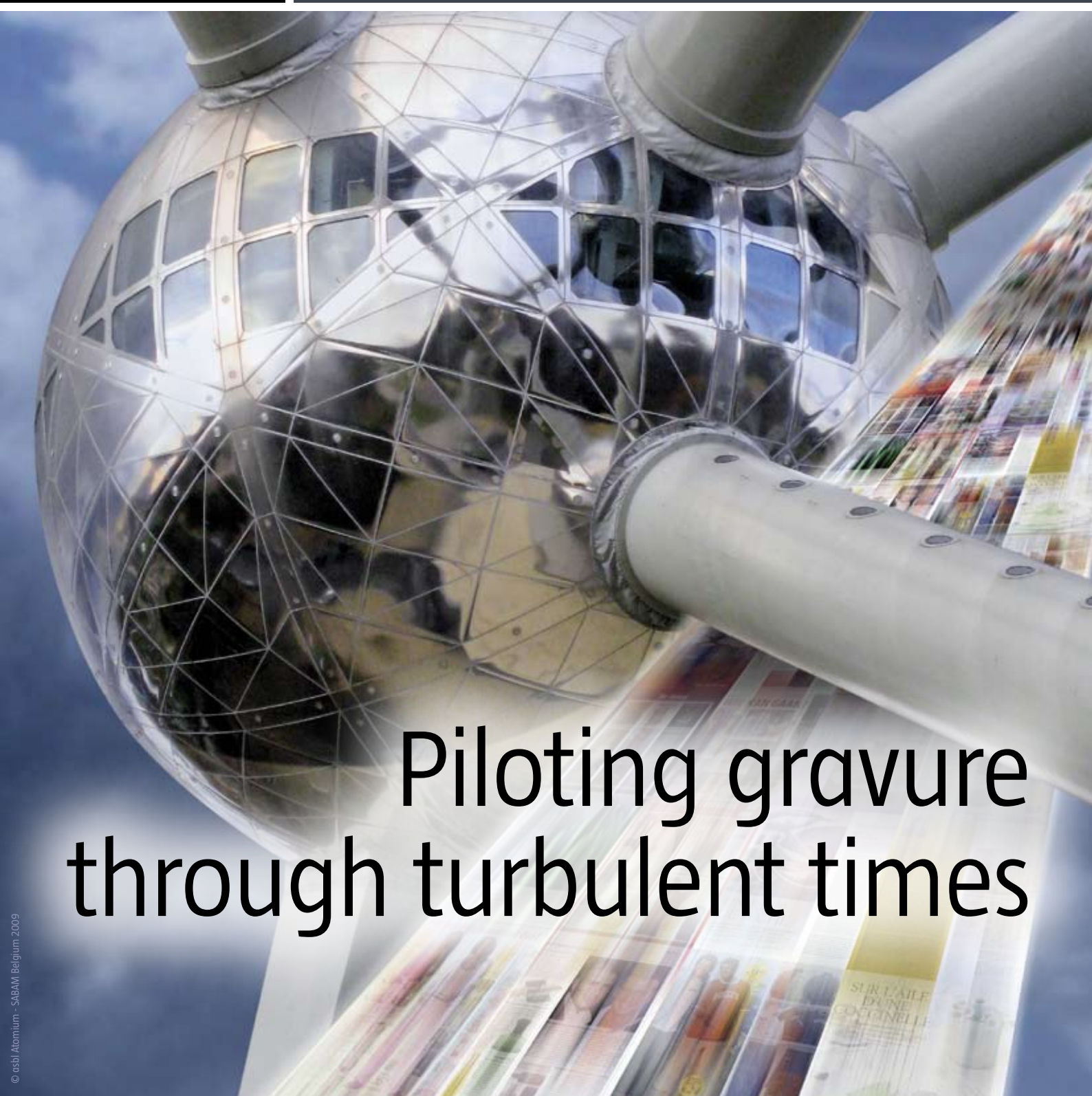

Plant Visit

Imprimerie Hélio Charleroi

Hélio Charleroi, located in the south of Brussels, is the only Belgian publication rotogravure facility, specialized in magazines, flyers and travel & mail order catalogues.

The company, built in 1988, was first partner with Dupuis, then with Hachette-E2G (1992-2002) before being totally owned by Quebecor (2005). In 2008, Quebecor sold its European activities to the Dutch HHBV group who created the Circle Printers group.

Hélio Charleroi employs 304 workers, is equipped with three 2.45 m and two 4.32 m presses, can engrave up to 22 000 cylinders/year and has a printing capacity of 210 000 tons of paper/year.
